_____Scopus IRD-2961: Unit includes (2) composite output via BNC connector, (2) stereo pair balanced analog audio via XLR connector, SNMP management (10/100 Base-T), Web based management (10/100 Base-T), and GPI.

_____Scientific-Atlanta's PowerVu® Model D9850: Receiver is designed for content distribution applications requiring 4:2:0 video decoding and offers features such as the capability to receive digitally-encrypted video, audio, utility data, IP data, and VBI.

TBN reserves the right to only provide affiliate either one of the first two models listed above (Scopus or SA PowerVu).

In order for each affiliate to receive authorization for equipment from TBN you must sign and complete this form (both pages) and mail, fax or email it back to TBN for processing and approval. TBN reserves the right to approve or disapprove affiliate's request for free equipment based on the current affiliate status and/or the cash incentive payments already received by affiliate.

1. TBN offers to provide IRD equipment to affiliates that meet the following criteria:
 - a. Are not currently receiving cash incentive payments from TBN.
 - b. Are receiving ongoing cash incentive payments from TBN, but the incentive payments are not sufficient to cover the cost of the equipment needed for the transition from analog to digital on Galaxy 14.

2. The following applies to cable affiliates that are already receiving ongoing cash incentive payments from TBN.
 - a. TBN will pay for the digital receiving equipment not to exceed \$1,000 per system headend.
 - b. TBN will withhold future cash incentive payments until the value of the IRD equipment equals the cumulative amount that would have been paid over a specific period of time.
 - c. Affiliates not currently under contract agree to a carriage term of TBN for 4 years from the date listed below.
 - d. Carriage of TBN's programming will be full-time (24 hours per day, 7 days per week).
 - e. If TBN is terminated before the end of the term, Affiliate may be liable to pay TBN a pro rata amount based on the period that TBN did not receive carriage.

3. Affiliate agrees that the satellite receiving equipment is for the sole purpose of receiving TBN's digital signal and changing from analog receivers to digital receivers due to TBN's change from analog to digital on Galaxy 14.
